**As David exclaims in Psalm 23: “My cup runneth over,” and we are so blessed by your fellowship, friendship, and support. Thank you all!**

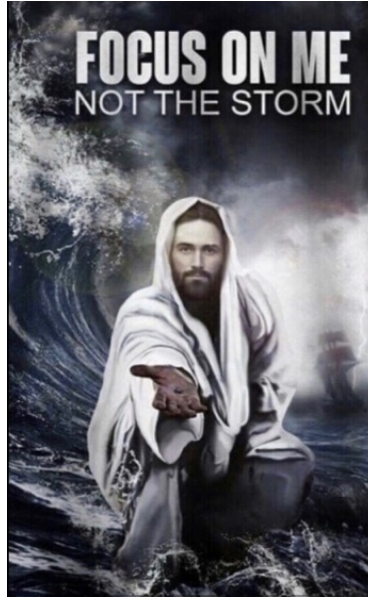
**In our verse from 2 Corinthians 13:14, Paul prays for Christian fellowship for the church of Corinth (and believers today), describing each member of the Godhead:**
